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3. "FORM FOLLOWS FUNCTION: The Art & Science of Creating Standards Based Materials" STARTS JUNE 16

WHEN: June 16 to July 7 WHAT: EDUX 5670 A, B, C, OR D

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course provides educators with the opportunity to discover and create effective projects and processes that will enrich student learning in areas across the curriculum. It will assist participants in developing materials that will capture students' attention and inspire their imagination. The course presents various ways educators can bring out student creativity and improve self-image as children find expression. Participants will construct materials to assist in differentiated instruction, incorporating exciting projects into the core curriculum for use in learning centers and/or cooperative learning groups.
