COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course emphasizes the acquisition of methods and the development of lessons that teach reading comprehension. The use of different resources in media, interactive exercise, and standard-based examples will be demonstrated and illustrated for use in the classroom. In this course participants will be directed to the California State Standards as a starting point for lesson planning. Examples will be described and modeled as a guide to the development of each participant’s personal lesson plans.
