**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course assists teachers in streamlining their classrooms for maximum individual responsibility, minimum stress, and superior achievement. Participants will focus on procedures for maximizing the use of time for instruction and learning. Methods for the delegation of responsibility and consequences for students who detract from the ongoing educational process will be covered as well as ways teachers can maintain a quality learning environment without overtaxing their energies or their pocketbook.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course focuses on the mechanical aspect of setting up an effective learning environment for students. Through classroom discussion, presentations and review of research materials, participants will gain new ideas and confirm their own knowledge related to proper management of the classroom.

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
