COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is designed to aid teachers in the process of developing effective strategies and proven techniques conducive to improving student self-esteem, classroom participation, and learning retention. Activities that extend children's knowledge beyond the basic curriculum and provide thoughtful approaches to content will be presented. Program suggestions will be explored that can be used with students at all learning levels. COURSE DESCRIPTION: In this course participants will learn how to translate the common core standards into practice. They also will work on strategies to accelerate student achievement. This course combines educational theory and practical implementation of the Common Core State Standards.

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
