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Course #EDUX 5390 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

WHEN: March 4, 6, 11, 13 & 18, 2019 (plus online and outside practicum)

4:00 – 8:00 PM *NOTE: This course is a hybrid of face-to-face and online learning.*

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course will assist classroom teachers to optimize the learning experience for students in the multicultural classroom. It will support educators in a pluralistic society to remain sensitive to the learning needs, personal interests and cultural characteristics of their students. The course further supports classroom teachers in helping them more fully understand the goal of multicultural education in creating educational opportunities that are equal for all students and in helping every child acquire the knowledge, attitudes, and skills needed to function effectively in a democratic society.

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
