**WHEN:** September 8 – October 6, 2024

**WHAT:** Course #EDUX 5700 A, B, C OR D

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course is designed to add successful models of student-teacher interaction to the repertoire of working educators. Teaching and learning processes can be carefully examined. Participants will investigate all aspects of the classroom climate as it relates to the rules of conduct and social interaction of students and teachers. Participants can explore ways to reach out to students and bring them fully into the learning process. Educators will examine various methods to improve the stress levels and atmosphere of their classroom, resulting in greater enjoyment of the teaching and learning processes.

### 2. "THE CREATIVE CLASSROOM: THINKING OUTSIDE THE BOX"

**WHEN:** October 21 – November 17, 2024

**WHAT:** Course #EDUX 5560 A, B, C OR D

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This course showcases a variety of exciting techniques that help release the creativity of educators and their students. While scripted instruction weakens the ability of students to problem-solve creatively, this course offers inventive practices that motivate students and bring mundane aspects of the curriculum to life in ways that reward and enrich every child's learning experience. Enrichment concepts can be applied across the curriculum including-language arts, social science, math and science. Participants will explore presentation formats and develop a portfolio of exciting ideas that include application to the whole teaching/learning experience.
