WHEN: May 2 - 16, 2022 (plus online and outside practicum)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course will explore effective practices for working with children deemed to be at risk of educational failure. Participants will examine ways that they can work together with their schools to engage students and motivate them toward success. The use of creative and flexible scheduling to extend learning time, differentiating instruction, organizing heterogeneous student groupings and designing classrooms to accommodate different learning styles are some of the ways educators can effectively improve the learning environment for all students, including children considered at risk.

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| 2. "ORGANIZING THE CLASSROOM FOR MAXIMUM ACHIEVEMENT" | STARTS JUNE 13 |
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Course #EDUX 5510 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course assists teachers in streamlining their classrooms for maximum individual responsibility, minimum stress, and superior achievement. Methods for the delegation of responsibility and consequences for students who detract from the ongoing educational process will be covered as well as ways teachers can maintain a quality learning environment without overtaxing their energies or their pocketbook.
