- 1. "CLASSROOM DISCIPLINE: ENCOURAGING SELF-RELIANCE & RESPONSIBILITY IN STUDENTS" STARTS SEPT 4**
Course #EDUX 5130 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

WHEN: Sept 4-18, 2024 (includes online and outside practicum)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is designed for teachers who wish to improve classroom discipline, encourage student self-reliance and optimize the learning atmosphere for everyone. While enhancing their natural disciplinary style, participants will also experience a broad range of innovative and time-tested approaches to this oldest of classroom problems.

- 2. "ORGANIZING THE CLASSROOM FOR MAXIMUM ACHIEVEMENT" STARTS OCT 2**
Course #EDUX 5510 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

WHEN: Oct 2 - 16, 2024 (includes online and outside practicum)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course assists teachers in streamlining their classrooms for maximum individual responsibility, minimum stress, and superior achievement. Participants will focus on procedures for maximizing the use of time for instruction and learning. Methods for the delegation of responsibility and consequences for students who detract from the ongoing educational process will be covered as well as ways teachers can maintain a quality learning environment without overtaxing their energies or their pocketbook.

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- 3. "ENERGIZE YOUR CLASSROOM WITH MOTIVATING MATERIALS" STARTS NOV 5**

Course #EDUX 5650 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

WHEN: Nov 5 - 19, 2024 (includes online and outside practicum)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course teaches participants how to bring out the best in their students and energize their classroom with materials that brighten, inspire and motivate. This course provides creative impetus, dazzling templates and models, and a plethora of material designs and ideas to brighten every classroom. This course helps participants reinvent their classroom design to excite and engage their students. Projects that relate to State Content Standards and fulfill District Mandates will be presented.

- 4. "RELIEVING STRESS IN THE CLASSROOM" STARTS DEC 3**

Course #EDUX 5710 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

WHEN: Dec 3 - 10, 2024 (includes online and outside practicum)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: In this course participants will explore all aspects of the teaching/learning process that may contribute to stress in both educators and their students. Educators will develop organizational skills and strategies to alleviate the effects of pressure and anxiety. Because classroom and work-related stress can undermine teachers' ability to do their jobs effectively, techniques designed to help educators and students lower stress levels will be presented. Critical topics including relaxation techniques, room environment changes and interpersonal model changes will be addressed. Participants will share issues they confront in their classrooms and on their campuses and develop plans to make them more manageable.

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NOTE - these courses will be presented in our ONLINE/HYBRID format – Information will be emailed upon enrollment, and course will consist of 45 total hours of online learning and outside practicum.
