1. "BEAT THE CLOCK: MAKING THE MOST OF INSTRUCTIONAL TIME" STARTS MAY 3

Course #EDUX 5100 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

WHEN: May 3 - 17, 2022 (plus online and outside practicum)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Time is one of the most precious commodities of the classroom teacher. This
course focuses on improving classroom management systems and tools to maximize instructional time.
Participants will examine ways to minimize distractions, develop effective transition strategies and
improve flow as students move from one task to another. Helping students maintain focus and develop
good study skills will also be an outcome of this class.

4. "WORKING WITH CHALLENGING STUDENTS: BULLIES AND VICTIMS" STARTS JUNE 14 Course #EDUX 5450 A, B, C or D (A New Course)

WHEN: June 14 - 28, 2022 (plus online and outside practicum)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course will offer participants the opportunity to collaborate with fellow teachers and administrators in order to better understand the negative impact of bullying behavior. During this course, participants will develop ways to work with bullies and victims, improve the self-image of both, and create ways to ensure that all students can learn in a safe and fear-free environment. As participants consider how bullying often obstructs the ability of students to progress both academically and socially, they will examine and collaborate on solutions to this serious issue in today's schools.
